Job Description

Seeking partnership with our community members who want to empower their own community/neighbors by providing saliva-based COVID-19 testing in trusted neighborhood sites. The testing team will help register members, guide members through saliva collection, and maintain testing protocols. Individuals seeking employment as a neighborhood testing team member should possess the following attributes:

- Affinity and compassion for the community being served.
- Skilled in listening, communicating, and building trust with people of different races, ethnicities, cultures, literacy levels, limited English language proficiency, and individuals with disabilities.
- Ability to communicate medical information in a manner that is respectful and responsive to the experiences, beliefs, culture, and practices of diverse populations.

Medical/Clinical Role:

Safety for staff and for the community members is of the utmost importance. Accordingly, the following guidelines are in place and will continue to develop over time:

- Adhere to Centers for Disease Control Personal Protection Equipment (CDC PPE) safety guidelines.
- Wear full PPE and change gloves between each test.
- Constantly wipe down and disinfect before, during, and after each test.

From a high level, this role will include the following tasks:

- Verify and respond to information collected by registration team.
- Maintain quality control for all tests performed.
- Oversee and guide patients through saliva-based testing.
- Assist community members who physically cannot perform the saliva testing themselves by guiding them step by step.
- Ensure saliva samples are properly placed into its vial and placed in shipping container.
- Assist with registration as needed.
- Prepare area for next community member's test.

Affinity, compassion, and active listening is a must along with the following:

- Engage and assist community members throughout the process.
- Ensure the community members feel welcome, cared for, and build inclusivity through mindful communication.

Medical/Clinical Staff:

- Highly prefer active members in the local community.
- Highly prefer community members with medical certification for instance Medical Assistant, CNA, etc.
- 1-2 years of work history is preferred.

Other Job-Related Information:

- Training will be provided.
- Safety clothing and gear will be provided.
- Government approved safety precautions will be in place.
- Beverages will be provided.

Candidates must be authorized to work in the United States without sponsorship. LTS cannot sponsor visas.
