Are you a low-income older adult and have a need for:

- Cat or Dog Food
- Veterinary Care (except spay/neuter)
- Boarding Expenses (temporary) while in hospital or nursing home

If so the Pet Assistance Program may be able to help you.



Guidelines for the Pet Assistance Program

You must be 60 years of age or older and a resident of Crawford County.

You must be in one of the following programs:

- Federal Public Housing Assistance including Section 8
- Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program
- Food Stamps
- SSI
- Medicaid
- Have income at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Level
\$1,471 for 1 person or \$1,991 for 2 people
